School Philosophy: Bay Presbyterian Nursery School opened its doors on September 15, 1964 as a non-profit school serving church members and area residents. The children and their families will also have the opportunity to help and love others through small ministry projects. It is our hope that our learning environment displays what it means to be a child of God: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
