

Rocky River Early Childhood PTA Kids Klosest Tips for Buyers

1. What you will find at the sale: gently used baby's and children's clothing and shoes/sandals/boots, clean toys, books, puzzles, music/videos/DVDs, baby/todder furniture, car seats, strollers, highchairs, cribs/beds, bouncy seats, swings, bouncy seats, clean bedding, age appropriate sports gear, tricycles/bicycles, etc.
2. Bring change! You will be paying each seller individually, so it is easiest have small bills and change. RRECPTA will NOT be providing change.
3. Think about the next six months. What events will your children be attending? What vacations will you be taking? It is often helpful to make a list of the clothing and other items which you will need. Note the sizes of your nieces, nephews and the other kids in your life in case you find something that they might like.
4. Bring a large bag with handles to carry your items while you are at the sale. Many sellers will have bags, but some may run out.
5. Children are permitted at the sale. However, your shopping experience may be more pleasant if you do not have to carefully supervise youngsters. The sale can become very hectic and crowded; small children may be overwhelmed.
