

Adult Wellness and Networking - Plan and schedule monthly events for members or members and significant others. 2018 events included: baseball game, dinner night, vase-making, and wine tasting. This is a year-long commitment with moderate monthly responsibilities and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair or co-chair.

Auction Coordinator - Plan and execute our largest fundraising event. Tasks include: securing donations, securing sponsorship, planning event with venue, organizing donations, set-up and running event, selling auction night tickets, and collecting winning bid amounts. This commitment requires high active participation and RRECP-TA meeting attendance for chair and support team from late August through late November

Auction Support Team -- Support Auction Coordinator with the above responsibilities. This commitment requires high active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair and support team from late August through late November.

Audit Committee - Perform the annual audit of the organization's expenses. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for committee members from late April through June.

Bike Parade - Plan and execute the Bike Parade at River Days. Tasks include: Organizing the event and securing donations for the Bike Parade raffle. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair and co-chair from June through mid-July.

Family Support and Resources - Plan monthly dinners, share resource information among group members, and organizing monthly playdates designed for the unique needs of group members. This is a year-long commitment with light monthly responsibilities and RRECPTA meeting attendance.
