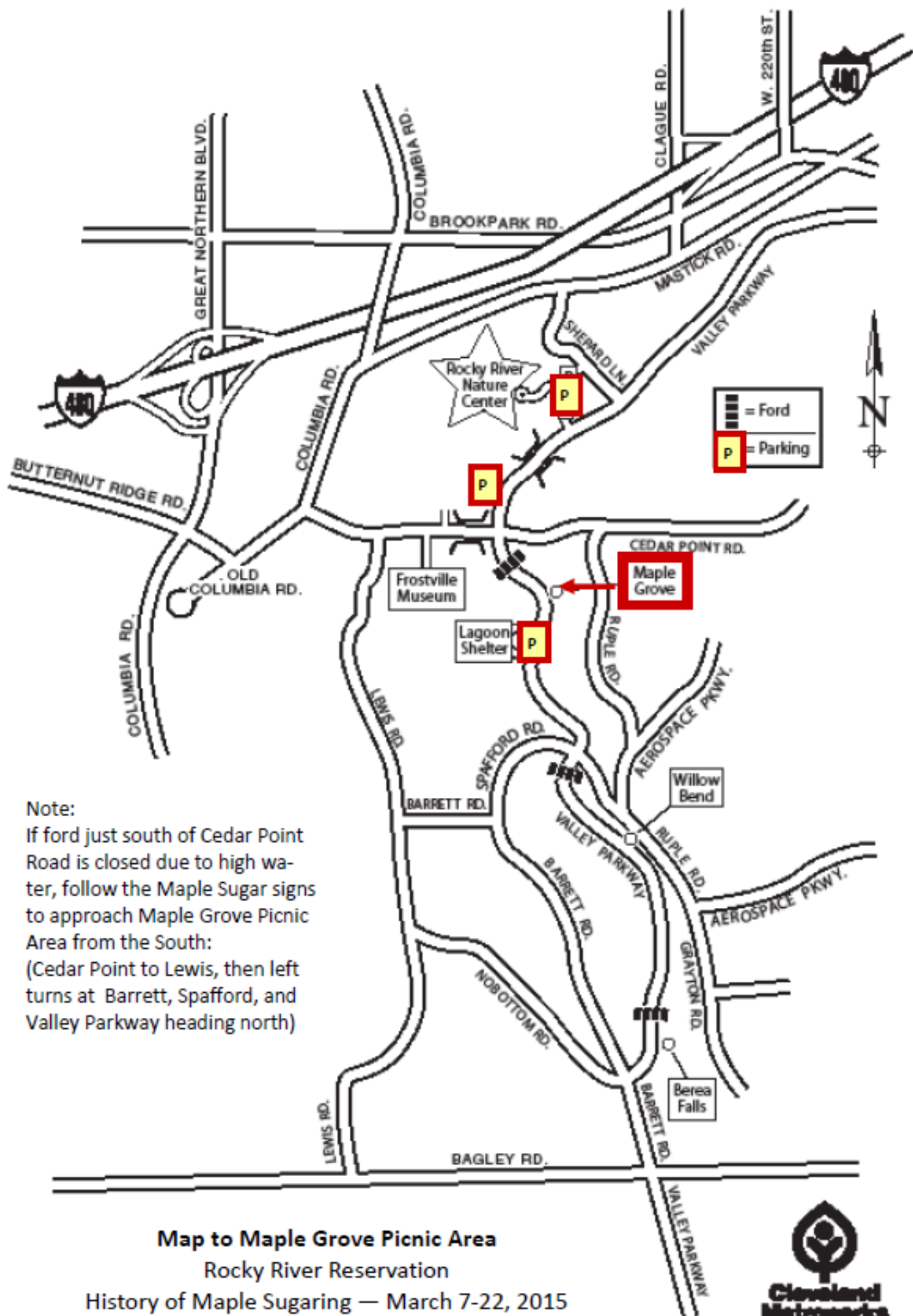

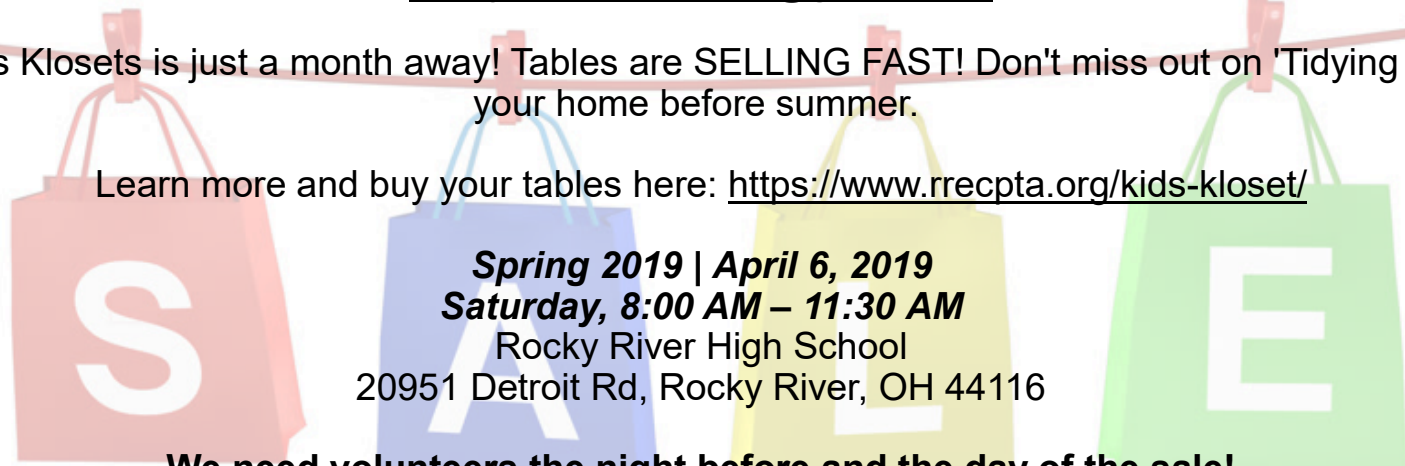

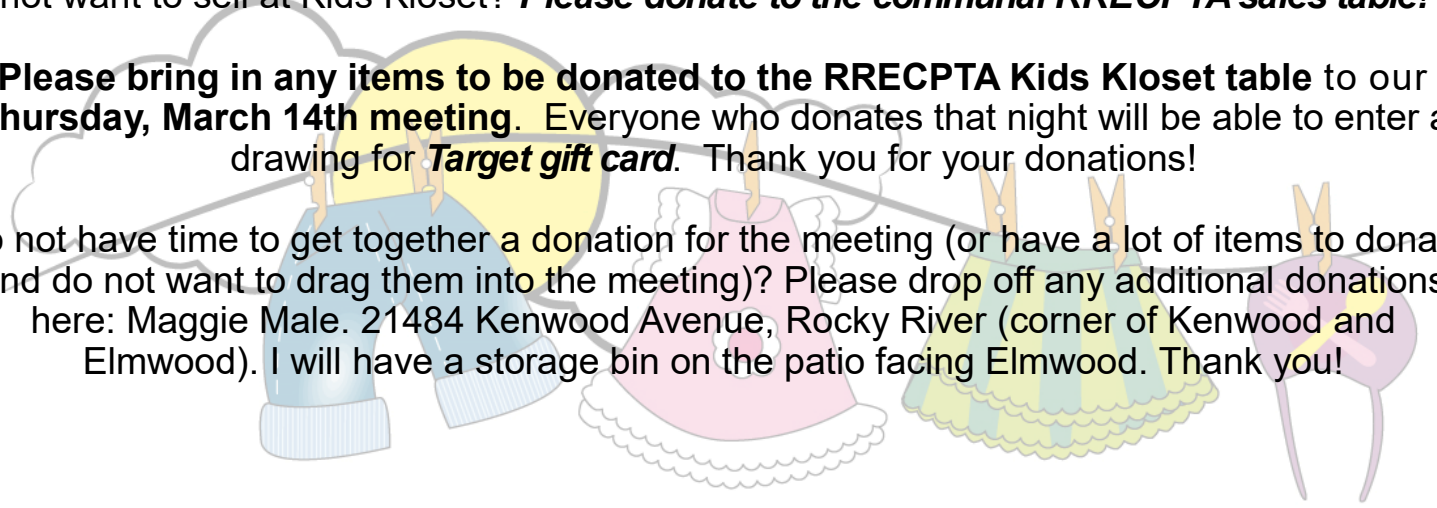

Auction Support Team (1 position open) - Support Auction Coordinator with the above responsibilities. This commitment requires high active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair and support team from late August through late November.

Audit Committee (3 positions open) - Perform the annual audit of the organization's expenses. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for committee members from late April through June.

Bike Parade (2 positions open) - Plan and execute the Bike Parade at River Days. Tasks include: Organizing the event and securing donations for the Bike Parade raffle. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair and co-chair from June through mid-July.

Party, Winter Wiggles (2 positions open) - Coordinate event in February. Tasks include: Planning the event with the venue, booking inflatable rental, getting supplies from storage shed, purchasing food and drink for the event, securing volunteers (members and Key Club), creating Evite for sign-up, overseeing set-up, event, and clean-up. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair or co-chair from December through February.

Party, Ice Skating (1 position open) - Schedule event in March. Tasks include: Planning the event with the Recreation Center, purchasing food and drink for the event, securing volunteers (members), creating Evite for sign-up, overseeing set-up, event, and clean-up. This commitment requires moderate active participation and RRECPTA meeting attendance for chair or co-chair from January through March.
